RULES AND REGULATIONS

United States Equestrian Federation Entry Agreement

I have read the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") Entry Agreement (GR906.4) as printed in the Prize List for [Minnesota Breeders Inc, Fall Festival Show] ("Competition") and agree to all of its provisions. I understand and agree that by entering this Competition, I am subject to Federation Rules, the Prize List, and local rules of the competition. I agree to waive the right to the use of my photos from the competition and agree that any actions against the Federation must be brought in New York State.

The complete statement is as follows:

Federation Entry Agreement: By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur, and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition.

I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules.

I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered.

I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

US Equestrian Membership Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$85 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

MAHB Fall Festival is a USEF Local rated competition. USEF Local rated competitions require trainers and coaches who sign the entry form to be USEF participating members with current Safe Sport Training. Trainers and coaches are ineligible for a show pass at this competition and must be current active USEF members. All other exhibitors, owners, riders, and handlers are not required to be USEF members; however, any exhibitor who does hold an active USEF membership at the time of the show must be current on their Safe Sport Training.

AHA Membership Statement

Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches and the person(s) signing the entry blank) in an Arabian Horse Association recognized arabian division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA membership/competition card, join AHA or pay an AHA single event membership fee per competitor. When an agent signs for the owner at an AHA recognized competition, both the owner and agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA single event membership. Single event membership is not acceptable at AHA regional or national competitions. Exhibitors in walk-trot classes are exempt from AHA membership requirements at qualifying competitions, but must have an AHA membership with competition card at AHA regional and national competitions. Exhibitors in lead line classes or parents/guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA membership requirements. (bod 5/12)

THE MINNESOTA ARABIAN HORSE BREEDERS, INC. (MAHB, INC.) will **NOT** be responsible for any loss or damage or injury to horses exhibited, or for any articles of any kind or nature that may be lost or destroyed, or in any way injured. Each Exhibitor is responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person, or thing, whomsoever, by any horse or vehicle owned or exhibited by him and will not in any case hold the Minnesota Arabian Horse Breeders, this show, its official or employees, or the sponsoring organization or its members responsible for loss or injury of or to any animal, vehicle or article owned or exhibited by them. All horses exhibited in this show will be entirely at the owner's risk. **THE SHOW** reserves the right to make such changes in procedures, personnel, rules, and regulations as shall be deemed by them to be in the best interest of this show; any such changes will be posted in the Show Office.

Cancellation or Date Change Of Show: Management reserves the right to change the dates and/or the location of the show or to cancel the show altogether. In the event of a cancellation, all entry fees and stall fees will be refunded upon request. (Office fees are non-refundable.) Neither MAHB, USEF nor AHA shall have any liability to any exhibitor, owner, handler or other person, firm, or corporation by reason of any change or cancellation of the show, except for the return of the aforementioned fees.

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. ARABIAN REGISTRY REQUIREMENT:

Horses shown in Purebred Arabian Division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association (or in the case of a foreign entry, have been issued a Competition Visa by the Arabian Horse Association) and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry or, if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for (exception: Art. 1699N.1) and must be entered under their full registered name. **A COPY OF REGISTRATION PAPERS, FRONT AND BACK, MUST BE INCLUDED WITH THE ENTRY FORM. HORSES MUST BE REGISTERED WITH AHA – NO PENDING HORSES.**

AGE OF THE HORSE: The age of a horse shall be reckoned as beginning on January 1st of the year in which it was born.

MAHB REGISTRY REQUIREMENTS: All horses must be registered with MAHB, and a copy of their MAHB Registration Certificate must be included with the entry.

ELIGIBILITY: Only those horses whose dams were nominated into the Minnesota Arabian Horse Breeders, Inc. Futurity programs in the year they were bred are eligible to show in MAHB Halter and/or Performance Futurity classes, with the exception of MAHB Performance nominations as set forth below.

a.) Any Medallion Stallion foal that has already met the nomination requirements of being nominated into the MAHB, Inc. futurity programs (including payment of \$125.00 to MAHB on or before December 31st of the year the dam of the foal was bred) will be eligible to show in the appropriate classes beginning as a yearling, starting 1991.

b.) Beginning in 2012, offspring of Medallion Stallions not previously eligible can be nominated for Performance classes under the following rules:

1. Nominations are for performance classes and jackpot halter only.
2. Nomination Fee: \$50.00 for 2026
3. Nomination open to horses of all ages
4. Horse must be offspring of any Medallion Stallion.

EXHIBITOR PACKETS: Will **NOT** be released until all entries are complete.

HANDLER, RIDER AND/OR DRIVER SUBSTITUTION: If it is necessary to change riders or handlers after the close of entries, a replacement may be made. If the replacement is not a currently Certified Amateur, application must be made at the Show at least ONE HOUR prior to the class. Horses shall be handled and shown throughout the entire class by only one and the same person. With the exception that a substitute rider, driver or handler may be used if during the class the original rider, driver or handler becomes ill or injured. **NO PERSON CAN SHOW IN MORE THAN ONE SECTION OF THE SAME CLASS.**

AGE OF RIDER: The age of a rider shall be determined as of December 1 of each year and shall be maintained until December 1 of the following year.

ATTIRE: It is the tradition of the show ring that riders, drivers and handlers be correctly attired for each class and that attendants be neatly dressed and the horses properly presented. The management may, at its discretion, bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

ADMISSION TO ARENA: No person will be permitted to enter the arena except participants in the class, officials and their assistants and the show photographer. Attendants will not be permitted in the arena until summoned by the Judges.

CALL FOR CLASSES: Classes will be called promptly. There will be three calls for classes. Two minutes will be allowed after the first horse enters the ring. In case of equipment change, an additional three minutes may be allowed; provided the gate is notified at least one class in advance. Due to possible unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and class calls over that system are considered a courtesy.

MISSED CALLS FOR CLASSES: It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have his/her horse at the gate at the prescribed time. While every effort is made to maintain a working PA system, NO protest will be upheld, nor any section changed on the basis of PA failure.

MAHB POST ENTRIES: Accepted after the closing date of August 31st until September 19th. No entries accepted after September 19th, 2026. MAHB Classes will have a \$50 post entry fee per horse. If the horse was entered on time in a MAHB class, there will be no post entry fee if the horse post enters AHA classes.

AHA POST ENTRIES: Accepted after the closing date of August 31st. AHA Classes will have a \$50 post entry fee per horse. Entries will be accepted at the stated post entry fees up to one hour prior to the start of each session and, thereafter, up to five classes prior to the class to be entered.

NUMBER OF ENTRIES IN CLASSES: All classes will be judged regardless of the number of entries.

SPLITTING OF CLASSES: According to Minnesota Arabian Horse Breeder Futurity Rules, each section of a futurity class is considered part of the same class. Show management will determine number of horses in any section of any class. The colts/geldings and fillies will be shown in separate halter classes. The only random draw for sections will be with performance horses. **No handler/rider may show more than one entry per class.** Order of go is according to age, oldest to youngest. Exhibitors will be required to check in with the Assistant Paddock Master prior to the start of the class to verify their position.

PROTESTS: A protest may be made to the Show Committee by an exhibitor, owner, agent, trainer, or the parent of a junior exhibitor for any violation of USEF rules. It must be in writing, signed by the protester, addressed to the secretary of the competition at which the alleged violation occurred; accompanied by a deposit of \$200.00 if made by a USEF Member or \$300 if made by a Non-Member; (if check, payable to the competition). It must be received by the steward, technical delegate, a member of the Show Committee, the competition manager of the competition or the competition secretary within 48 hours of the alleged violation.

NO SHOWS: To expedite the flow of classes it would be appreciated if last-minute scratches were reported to the show office as quickly as possible.

STALLIONS: Colts/Stallions may be shown by ladies or 18 and under exhibitors.

IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS: Every horse entered in this show will be assigned identification numbers. It is important for the proper handling of the show that the correct number be worn by rider/driver/handlers. Numbers will be marked clearly on the back with the horse's name and class in which the horse is entered.

WHIPS: One whip or cropper handler allowed, however, whips are not mandatory and handlers are allowed to use items such as grass, hat and/or treats to maintain horse's attention in halter classes. Whips are to be no longer than 6' (six feet) including the snapper/lash/appendage. Small appendages (no more than 12 inches in length) of ribbon, plastic, etc. are permitted. Excessive or improper use of a whip shall be basis for disqualification.

DISCIPLINE/ABUSE: If it is ascertained that any exhibitor has made or caused to be made any false statement in regard to any animal or article exhibited, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with any of the judges in the performance of his or her duties, said exhibitor shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting. Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials of this show on the part of the owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, driver, or handler will disqualify the horse from adjudication. Show Management reserves the right to remove any of the above listed from the show without being liable for compensation or damages. Any action(s) against a horse by an exhibitor which are deemed excessive by a judge, USEF steward or show veterinarian, in the show ring or anywhere on the competition grounds may be punished by official warning, elimination or other sanctions that may be deemed appropriate by the Show Committee. Such action(s) could include but are not limited to excessive use of whips, spurs, or bamboo poles.

PARTICIPANT/ EXHIBITOR INFORMATION: Owners and Exhibitors are hereby notified that the MAHB Board of Directors will strictly enforce and support all AHA and/or USEF rules, penalties, eliminations, sportsmanship, conduct and regulations. This includes but is not limited to rules that govern owners, exhibitors, agents, trainers, managers, riders, drivers, handlers, competition officials, competition employees and members of the families of the above, individual members of AHA or any person who acts in a manner in violation of the rules or deemed prejudicial to its best interests. Any AHA and/or USEF violations committed will be subject to the AHA and/or USEF penalties.

COVID-19 ACTION PLAN: Every exhibitor and participant agrees to abide by the US Equestrian Federation COVID-19 Action Plan Requirements. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, all programs, properties, events, and related specifications are subject to change in accordance with federal, state, and local laws and regulations. The plan can be found here: <https://www.usef.org/media/coronavirus-resources>.

ARENA & WARM UP RING DIMENSIONS: The Show arena is 100' x 210', with sand and loam mix for the footing. The indoor warm-up arena is 80' x 130' with sand and dirt footing. The outdoor warmup arenas are 100' x 100' with sand footing.

USEF DRUGS AND MEDICATION: "To provide funds for research, inspection and enforcement of rules regarding use of medication and drugs, each recognized show must assess a Drug Fee of \$23.00 (\$15.00 shall be an Equine Drugs and Medication fee, \$8.00 is a USEF fee.) for each horse entered in the show. At the end of a show, Show Management shall forward to the Association a sum representing the number of horses entered in the show, such to be held by the Association in a separate fund for use in accomplishing the purpose set forth above."

IRS INFORMATION: Please note that the IRS requires us to have appropriate tax ID or Social Security numbers before we can issue any winnings check. Failure to report this information or providing erroneous identification can lead to substantial penalties. We take any possibility of identity theft very seriously, and do keep tax ID and SS numbers in strict confidence. It is essential that you provide correct tax information with your entries to avoid delays in receiving your winnings. Please also note that the tax ID information must match the name on the entry form, and you must identify if you are out of the United States.

PRIZE MONEY AND AWARDS: Ribbons and trophies will be awarded in the show ring. All prize money will be sent within 60 days after close of the show. AHA Classes have NO PRIZE MONEY, only ribbons. In the event of a protest, only the prize money in question will be escrowed until USEF makes a determination. In the event USEF upholds a protest, all affected placings will be adjusted and the reserve horse will receive its proper ribbons and prizes.

IN-HAND/BREEDING CLASSES: Horses must be serviceably sound i.e. horse must not show evidence of lameness, broken wind or complete loss of sight in either eye. Transmissible weaknesses shall be considered a serious fault in breeding stock. Colts and stallions 2 years old and over must have both testicles descended. Halter horses are not to be stretched. A horse is considered not stretched if all four feet are flat on the ground and at least one front and one rear cannon bone is perpendicular to the ground. Excessive use of the whip or actions that may disturb other entries shall be severely penalized.

PERFORMANCE CLASSES: All horses shall be worked at all gaits both ways of the ring and otherwise as described by class specifications, and at Judge's discretion, horses shall change from any gait to any other gait. All horses chosen for a work-off must be worked both ways of the ring at any gait listed in class specifications as requested by the Judge. Horses must come to the "line up" at gait requested. In the "line up" horses must stand quietly and may be asked to back individually or as a group. Horses not to stretch on the line. Novice horses must not have won 3 first place ribbons respectively at Arabian Division Competitions in that particular performance section in which they are shown.

SADDLE SEAT PLEASURE: English and Country English horses will be accepted in these classes. Novice horses must not have won 3 first place ribbons respectively at Arabian Division Competitions in that particular performance section in which they are shown. Junior horses must comply with the USEF class specs in these divisions.

MOST CLASSIC HEAD: Open to all MAHB nominated stallions, mares and geldings. Entries shall be one year old and over and shown in a plain, unmarked sheet or cooler. You will enter at a walk and line up for further inspection.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

JUDGING/SCORING SYSTEM: The Majority Opinion System (MOS) will be used in all classes, including Breeding and Gelding In-Hand classes. Exceptions: Reining Classes where one judge will adjudicate. Performance Halter will use the AHA score card, the scorecards will be turned into placings and in turn, run through the MOS system to determine placement.

SHARPS CONTAINERS: Competition management shall place a minimum of one sharps container per each competition, whether or not stabling is provided. Additionally, at least one sharps container per fifty occupied stalls for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses. It is competition management's responsibility to replace such containers when full and dispose of them properly. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors or their agents up to \$100.00 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

SAFE SPORT: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U. S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. LOOSE DOGS - GR1301.6 Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule will be issued a Yellow warning card and may be subject to penalty under Chapter 7.

COMPETITION STEWARDS AND/OR TECHNICAL DELEGATES WILL BE CIRCULATING THROUGH STABLING AREAS DAILY AND WILL ISSUE YELLOW WARNING CARDS TO DOG OWNERS FAILING TO HOLD THEIR DOG ON A LEASH OR OTHERWISE RESTRAIN THEIR DOG.

PRINTING ERRORS: The show committee is not responsible for errors in printing. Corrections will be posted in the Show Office

ANNOUNCEMENT ABOUT TBA CLASSES

TO BE ANNOUNCED (TBA) CLASSES: Contact the show secretary to purchase a TBA class. TBA classes will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. TBA class slots may be restricted to the type of class that can be purchased, please see the show schedule for restricted TBA classes. MAHB retains the right to refuse any TBA class request for any reason, including but not limited to, those that do not fit into the show schedule or is excessively restrictive in those who can participate. Only AHA main ring classes can be purchased as TBA's unless the type of restriction states otherwise. Those purchasing TBA classes will be required to pay a \$50 Fee, which includes the class entry fees. TBA class names and numbers will be posted on the Facebook Page as they are filled and will be posted in the show office during the show. Post entry fees will not be charged for TBA classes entered after the Pre-Entry deadline has passed. Type restricted TBA classes that have not been filled by the Pre-Entry deadline may have the restriction removed at management's discretion. The TBA purchase fee will be refunded if a minimum of four(4) eligible and paid entries are received. The show committee reserves the right to decline a class request.

The following classes are restricted and cannot be requested as TBA classes: Dressage, Western Dressage, Cow classes, Hunter Over Fences, Jumper, Trail, Carriage Driving classes.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

ALL HORSES ON THE SHOW FAIRGROUNDS MUST HAVE ORIGINAL CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS. ORIGINAL AND A COPY MUST BE PRESENTED IN THE SHOW OFFICE FOR ALL ENTRIES. MEDALLION STALLIONS AND OTHER HORSES ON THE GROUNDS NOT ENTERED IN CLASSES MUST HAVE ORIGINAL READY FOR PRESENTATION UPON REQUEST.

ARRIVAL TIME: No barn access until Wednesday, September 23, 2 p.m., no exceptions.
Include stall requests (with what barn) with entries or call Barn Manager with special requests. Stall set up may begin at 2 p.m. on Wednesday, September 24
Horses may arrive at 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 23
Include shavings request with entries; we will try to deliver Wednesday morning.
Stalls may not have artificial ceilings; fire code violations

DEPARTURE TIME: Sunday, September 27, 6:00 p.m. All horses, displays and barn decorations **MUST** be out of the barn no later than 8:00 p.m. **Absolutely no stall tear down before the completion of the final class on Sunday. EXERCISE AREAS: Horses may be exercised in the outdoor arenas as weather permits, and in the indoor exercise area. No lunging will be allowed in the indoor warm-up area while the show is in session. Show management may limit exercise time as necessary.

BARN: All exhibitors are expected to maintain the aisles bordering their stalls in a clean and orderly manner. Shavings are not allowed in the barn aisles. All manure from daily cleanings must be put in designated areas. Please do not mix trash in with the manure, MAHB is charged for removal of all trash. In accordance with state fire regulations, no autos, trucks, or trailers will be permitted in the barn. After unloading, cars, trucks and trailers must be moved to the designated parking areas.

BEDDING: Due to environmental reasons, the use of straw is prohibited. All shavings must be pre-purchased. Cost of bedding is \$8:00/bag -2 bag minimum. Straw is NOT allowed. We are required to purchase all shavings through MEC so PLEASE remember to include your bedding order on your entries. Doing so will insure bedding will be in your stalls upon arrival. Grain and hay are the responsibility of the exhibitor.

NO CATS ALLOWED, ALL DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH, NO DOGS ALLOWED IN SHOW AREA WHILE SHOW IS IN SESSION. (EXCEPTION: SERVICE DOGS SUCH AS SEEING EYE, ETC.).

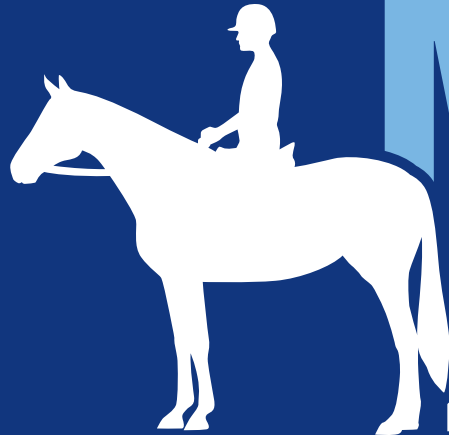

PARKING: All posted parking and traffic restrictions will be in full force and effect during the show.

STABLING: No showing out of trailers. Every horse is required to have a stall. Box stalls with doors are available. Anyone wishing to stall together must state clearly on entry form. Each exhibitor must pay for his or her own stalls.

Purpose of Form

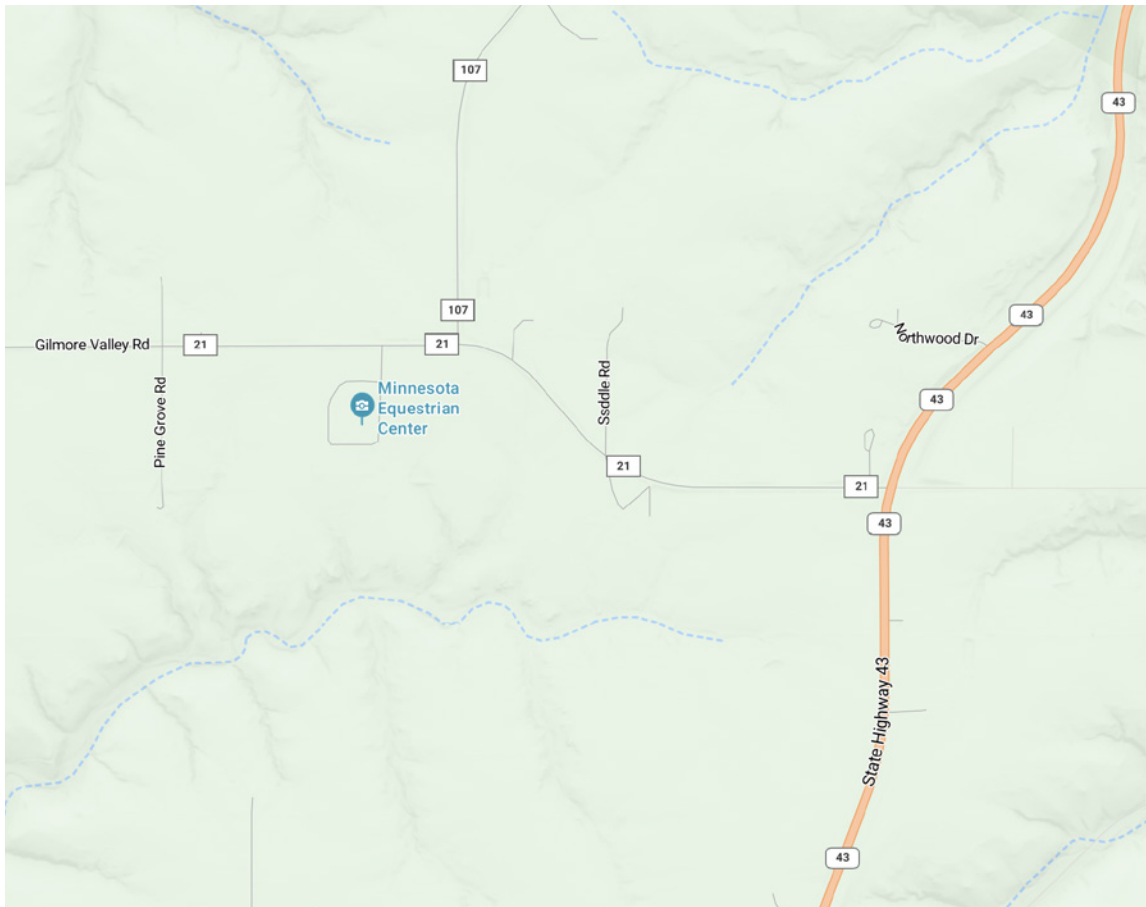
